## Biographies

### **Ivan McKee**

#### **Scottish Government Minister for Trade, Investment and Innovation**

Mr Ivan McKee, MSP, was born in Helensburgh, Dunbartonshire and brought up in Glasgow. He obtained a BSc BEng in Manufacturing Sciences and Engineering from the University of Strathclyde and an MBA from Newcastle University.

Following 2 years of voluntary service in Bangladesh with VSO, he worked for a variety of manufacturing companies. In 2005 he set up his own international manufacturing consultancy business and from 2009 to 2015 invested in, and successfully turned around, a number of manufacturing businesses including the rescue of Dunfermline based Simclar from Administration.

Mr McKee has significant international experience, having managed businesses in Scotland, England, Poland, Finland, Croatia and Bosnia. He is a Trustee of the charity CEI, which supports educational and health projects in rural Bangladesh. He is a member of the Board of Common Weal.

### **Sir Anton Muscatelli**

#### **Principal of the University of Glasgow**

Professor Sir Anton Muscatelli is a graduate of Glasgow University who began his post as Principal on 1 October 2009. He was knighted for services to higher education in the Queen's Birthday Honours in 2017.

Sir Anton Muscatelli graduated from the University, with an MA in Political Economy and with a PhD in Economics. He was a lecturer in Economics from 1984 and Daniel Jack Professor of Economics from 1992 until 2007.

He was Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences, 2000 to 2004, and Vice-Principal (Strategy, Budgeting and Advancement) from 2004 until 2007. He then moved to Heriot-Watt University where he was Principal and Vice-Chancellor from 2007 to 2009.

### **Carsten Mumm**

#### **Chief Economist Donner & Reuschel AG**

Carsten Mumm, CFA, is chief economist at DONNER & REUSCHEL AG, private bank. He is responsible for the preparation of the bank's economic and capital markets forecasts as well as the presentation of the expectations to customers, public and media.

Until 2016 Carsten was head of the asset management department including portfolio management for institutional and private clients as well as the capital markets analysis. In 2010 he was responsible for consolidating the two asset management teams during the merger of REUSCHEL & CO. and CONRAD HINRICH DONNER BANK AG. Carsten started his career as portfolio manager at CONRAD HINRICH DONNER in 2003 after studying economics at Hamburg University and completing his apprenticeship at Deutsche Bank AG. In 2006 he was awarded the CFA charter.

Since 2017, Carsten has been engaged as an associate lecturer at the International School of Management (ISM) in Hamburg.
